Il Leone Mastrantonio

Just down the road from us and one of Cape Town's most renowned, and we would say best, Italian restaurants in the city. Great atmosphere in an old house with high-quality authentic dishes. Amazing prawn linguine and Italian pork sausage pasta.

Manos

A Green Point institution that is always busy, serving a mix of Mediterranean and local classics so expect both great fish and meat. A no-frills no fuss place with good size portions and lively customers having long lazy lunches.

Hussar Grill

Meat is their passion accompanied by very good wine and if you bring your own, they don't charge corkage! This Moule Point branch is situated along a scenic route, looking out onto the seas horizon. Great starters like springbok carpaccio and baked camembert before the big steak knives come out!

SeaBreeze Fish & Shell

Traditional Cape Town seafood with a twist by Scottish owners. Located on the popular Bree Street in two heritage buildings there is a cocktail and oyster bar, they even have an Oyster Happy Hour.

Kloof Street House

Vadivelu

Black Sheep

Buzzing atmosphere and always packed with locals with massive chalkboard menus and portions to match. A firm favourite and four years after opening they opened a bar, Dark Horse, across the road. Order the fish quickly before it gets wiped from the board

The Pot Luck Club

A glass elevator takes you to the sixth floor of an old flour silo at The Biscuit Mill and is one of Cape Town's coolest spots for seeing and being seen. Sophisticated tapas and sharing plates, definitely try the grapefruit martini and enjoy the views of Table Mountain.
