# Oranjezicht City Farm Market

Supporting over 40 local farmers and 80 artisanal food traders since 2013 this fun market still grows its produce in the city bowl with its public market located in the V&A Waterfont. As well as a great choice of food and drink to eat on site they have a large selection of fresh fruit and veg, meats, breads and cakes plus one of the best cheese stalls c/o Jane.

## Time Out Market

This worldwide concept brings together a local mix of 13 kitchens and 3 bars with curated chefs from Cape Town and is the first on the African continent. Located at the Old Biscuit Mill this collaboration of local artisans, designers and foodies set the benchmark and was the pioneer in weekend markets back in 2006.
